Additional Information for Taxi Operation.

<u>Ordinance</u> 2001-01-Section 3.04 –Compliance with Municipalities and State Licensing Regulations.

Taxi monthly fee of \$200.00, due on the first day of the month. It can Be paid at Ground Transportation Office or CCAA receptionist desk Located on the Third Floor of the terminal. Mon-Fri 8:00 AM to 4:30 PM, Closed on holidays. Checks must be payable to "Charleston County Aviation Authority" or it may be abbreviated to "CCAA".

Must be equipped to accept all major Credit Cards (Ordinance 2001-01-Section 4.08- Credit Cards).

Must be equipped with a two-way radio system.

All operators must meet the minimum performance standard quota Which is %50 of average taxi trip count.

Taxi vehicles are subject to pre-permit issuance as well as semi-Annual inspections that are conducted by GT staff.

All vehicle drivers (including the owners) must provide SLED Report And Chauffeur's License copies to GTO.

All new drivers must complete a minimum of 8 trips with another qualified taxi driver. New drivers must also attend a driver's orientation class at GTO. All required documents must be turned in prior to driving.

All taxis are required to work a late flight schedule (10PM and later) on A rotational basis to accommodate for passengers arriving on late flights. Monthly late flight schedules are provided by GTO.
