

Insurance Indemnification

a Certificate of Insurance (COI) is required, naming the Charleston County Aviation Authority as additional insured. The

minimum limits of coverage shall be:

Commercial General Liability Insurance This includes but is not limited to personal injury, broad form contractual and broad form property damage (per accident)	Combined Single Limit \$2,000,000
Automobile Liability Insurance, bodily (per person) Property Damage (per accident)	Combined Single Limit \$1,000,000
Workman's Compensation	Per State Law

Evidence of insurance must be submitted and approved BEFORE filming begins. By submitting this application, the applicant agrees to the following: The applicant shall assume all risk in the use of Charleston County Aviation Authority's (Authority) property in the permitted operation and shall be solely responsible and answerable in damages for all accidents and injury to person or property and shall indemnify and hold harmless the Authority, its officers and employees from any and all claims, suits, losses, damages or injury to person or property. The applicant shall accept the responsibility to oversee all parties affiliated with the production and to ensure compliance with all applicable laws, policies, rules and regulations. Any violations may result in immediate revocation of the permit.

In addition to the daily charge, during the review process CCAA staff will determine if the desired filming location requires the assistance of airport employees (Police, Operations, Maintenance, etc...). The cost is \$75 per hour for each employee assigned. Overtime fees will be charged at time and a half.

Restricted Filming Areas

The filming of a commercial aircraft is not allowed without the expressed advance written permission from the commercial aircraft owner(s)/permittee(s) being filmed. Filming is not permitted inside the TSA security checkpoint, of checkpoint operations or any TSA employee without advance written permission from the Department of Homeland Security. Filming of any tenant or business and its employees in the airport requires advance permission from said business. It is the responsibility of the film permit applicant to obtain Letters of Agreement from the appropriate commercial aircraft owners(s)/permittee(s), TSA and DHS and airport tenants. Copies of all Letters of Agreements must be attached to this permit application.
